Thesis Advisory Committee Formation Rules

This document specifies the requirements on Thesis Advisory Committees ("Comissão de Acompanhamento de Tese" – abbreviated CAT) in the specific context of the Doctoral Program in Computer Science at FCT UNL, in addition to the general rules of the FCT UNL regulations concerning doctoral programs.

- 1. The proposal for CAT composition should be submitted to the CCPDI by the supervisor;
- 2. The proposal should indicate the full name, affiliation, and area of expertise of each member, as well as a justification for their inclusion in the CAT;
- 3. The CAT may include from 3 to 5 members. Among these, one must find
 - a. A DI FCT UNL faculty member, other than the supervisor
 - b. At least one member not affiliated with the FCT UNL
 - c. The supervisor(s).
 - d. A member with previous successfully concluded PhD supervision experience.
- 4. The CAT is chaired by a DI FCT UNL faculty member.
- 5. The CCPDI must notify the supervisor of CAT proposal approval or rejection within two weeks after its submission by the supervisor. In case of rejection, the CCPDI must issue a written justification for the decision.
- 6. The CA must be officially approved by the CCPDI at least one month before the submission by the candidate of a Thesis Plan Proposal.
